TOOLS TO AUTOMATE THIRD PARTY COMPLIANCE TRAINING

REQUIREMENTS QUESTIONS

As you evaluate EduNetwork, a series of tools within the web-based ComplianceWire® learning management system, you can use this form to determine your high-level business and compliance requirements. Your answers to this form will determine the UL EduNeering functionality that is available as part of our EduNetwork solution.

1:

Do you know the names of all the third party individuals who require training?

- ☐ **No.** EduNetwork includes a self-registration page and authentication codes that the primary contact can share with all of the third party users.
- ☐ **Yes.** You may not require the EduNetwork self-registration functionality, as ComplianceWire enables you to enter each third party name or accepts a data feed from your vendor management system, to eliminate manual entry.

2:

Is EACH third party account managed by a “Business Owner” within your organization who communicates with a contact within the third party?

- ☐ **No.** You may not require the EduNetwork T-PATT functionality, but rather, use ComplianceWire to include third party users without a link to a business owner.
- ☐ **Yes.** EduNetwork enables you to “attach” a business sponsor to the third party account, so that this sponsor inputs the number of third party individuals who need training, and is also copied on all critical notifications; in addition, this sponsor gains visibility into training completions status.

3:

Do you have a complex “training matrix” in which each third party individual must be categorized into a defined “role” that receives specific training?

- ☐ **No.** ComplianceWire supports a streamlined training approach in which all third party individuals can receive the same training content.
- ☐ **Yes.** The EduNetwork self-registration page enables you to capture attributes about an individual that will automatically drive the targeted training that they need based on their role, years of experience, region they serve, etc.

4:

Do you need to perform risk assessments on specific third party users to determine who is considered a “high risk” user, for purposes of additional compliance activities?

- ☐ **No.** The optional SmartForms tool may not be beneficial to your program at this time.
- ☐ **Yes.** An optional tool, SmartForms, enables you to add “rules” to risk assessments to categorize users into varying “risk” levels. For example, a learner must answer a specific question to be placed into a “high-risk” group that receives targeted training or other compliance activities.
